

Mutton Bustin' Entry and Release Form - August 16-19, 2017

Event Rules:

Child must be 6 or 7 years old as of the date of the rodeo and weigh less than 50lbs.

Rider will take a wool hold and ride for six seconds.

Child can use one or two hands.

Sheep shall be chute run and a committee member will put the child on the sheep. No helpers allowed in arena.

(Committee refers to those allowed in the arena during regular rodeo events: stock contractor, pick up men, clowns, judges, sports medicine personnel, and Inter-State Rodeo Committee Members.)

Contestants will remain in the arena until the event is over.

Contestants must dress western: Long sleeve shirt, jeans, and boots. Child will wear a bicycle helmet of his own or one furnished by the committee. No spurs allowed.

**Weigh in and proof of age is required. Violation of these rules will result in disqualification.
